

Name of intervention:

Indoor Lunch Club



Intent: To give children the choice to play inside or outside. To provide a safe space for those children who prefer a calmer environment, and children who can find it hard to make and maintain friendships.

Implementation: Indoor Lunch club runs every lunch time, and is available for the children to attend for the remainder of their lunch break, after they have eaten their lunch in the hall. Class teachers make a list of children who would like to attend each day. There is space for 8 children from each class. There are a variety of games, toys and jigsaws laid out for the children to play with. Key stage 2 children also have the choice to use Chrome Books.

Impact: Children feel happier knowing that there is a choice of play at lunch time. Children can have space away from their peers, choose a calmer activity, and talk to Mrs Taylor at Lunch club if they have any worries.
