

Name of intervention:

Sensory Garden



Intent: to enable children who need chance to regulate to have sensory breaks in an outdoor, enclosed environment.

Implementation: timetabled sensory breaks are implemented for named children. The Sensory Garden can also be accessed on an 'as and when needed' basis. There is an area under shelter, a sandpit and a small hut, alongside artificial grass, planters and a water feature.

Impact: children are able to access sensory breaks in an enclosed outdoor area. This mean our children have the necessary space to work through their emotions, in a secure environment.
