

Name of intervention: Comprehension Express/Project X



Intent: Comprehension express is a teaching programme specifically built to help children in years 4 to 6 effectively master comprehension and meet the expectations of the national curriculum. The aim is to develop strategies and skills to make sense of text 'in the moment' of reading.

Implementation: Group sessions of six children work twice a week using a range of resources consisting of expert tip cards, work books and reading collections with explicit modelling and supported practice. The expert tip cards provide visual prompts to help support the follow up written responses and independent thinking.

Impact: Entry and exit data is collected to assess progression. The programme expects to embed core comprehension strategies and develop deeper thinking and confidence in reading in each individual child.

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
