To offer a broad range of inclusive extracurricular activities to all pupils.	£1500	Run varied clubs accessible to all year groups and all groups of children. Use pupil voice to target which ones to put in place. Use membership to the Schools Games Partnership to ensure that children from vulnerable groups have opportunities to engage in competitive sports and festivals, in the same way their peers do.	Greater pupil enjoyment and skills development outside curriculum time, promoting lifelong physical activity habits. Representation of all groups of children in sports events and festivals throughout the year.
