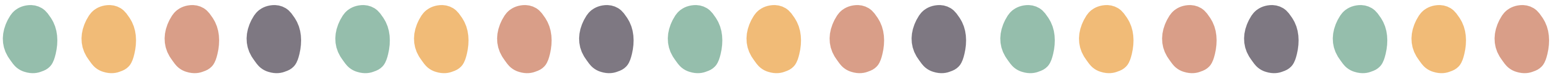

Glossary	• Coin - A coin is a unit of money used in the UK. One coin represents a value equivalent to a given number of one-pence coins. • Value - Where referring to money, value refers to how much something is worth. • Worth - Worth refers to the value that something has. In the context of money, it refers to how much money you would pay for something. • Efficient - Not wasting time or effort. An efficient strategy is one we can carry out easily. • Pound sign - The symbol used, written before the pounds digit, to show the unit we are working in is pounds. • One pound - This is one of the ways we record one pound. • Combine - To combine is to put parts together to make a whole. • Amount - An amount of something is a quantity of something. • Value - Where referring to money, value refers to how much something is worth. • Change - Change is the money returned after paying for something with more money than it costs.
